\$7,000 for Summer 2020 Academic Internships in Singapore

Saint Michael's College is pleased to announce the third annual competition of the **Global Citizenship Internship Program**, supported by a grant from Freeman Foundation. The College is now accepting applications for \$7,000 scholarships to fund an academic internship for eight weeks in Singapore, May 31-August 1, 2020. These scholarships will help offset the cost of internship placement, professional development support, travel, housing and meals in Singapore. In addition to the time spent at the internship site, students will have the opportunity to participate in a range of cultural and networking events organized by our local partners in Singapore. This international placement will count for a four-credit academic internship, which will include the completion of academic assignments submitted to the faculty supervisor, and Saint Michael's will waive the summer tuition for a four-credit course.

Those interested in applying for this scholarship must submit: 1) Freeman Scholarship application form; 2) an updated resume; and 3) and answers to the following questions. Submit application materials to the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

1. How will this internship advance your academic and career goals, and how might you share this experience with the campus community when you return?
2. What strengths would you bring to this internship, and what concerns if any do you have about this opportunity?
3. Do you have any additional information you wish to share with the selection committee that is not obvious from your academic transcript?
