## COURSE SEQUENCING

Below are possible configurations to assist in planning the completion of your 60-credit degree. As long as the guidelines below are met and the seven-year statute of limitations for degree completion is observed, you may sequence your courses to suit your individual educational needs and objectives. Part-time students may find it helpful to use the summer as the time to complete the thesis or major paper. The courses of study below, except for the two-year program, are only examples of how one might do part-time study. The \* indicates that only two electives are needed if you choose to do a thesis. Please note prerequisites for specific courses when planning your schedule.
