



Using Colleague Self-Service to Search and Register for Courses

Students are able to search for and register for courses using the Self-Service interface by logging in at <https://selfservice.smcvt.edu/Student> using their MikeNet credentials.


1. Go to <https://selfservice.smcvt.edu/Student> and login using your MikeNet credentials



2. After logging in, you will see your “welcome” page. To begin the registration process, click on the “Course Catalog” option



3. Using the “Advanced Search” tab, select the appropriate term you would like to register for (Winter Intersession 2021) and click “Search”



- You will then be brought to a screen where you see all 5 available courses. A list of courses should be presented on the right side of the screen. This will show details for the available sections, including seats available, schedule days and times, restrictions, course location and instructor.

ES-107 Environmental Science (4 Credits)

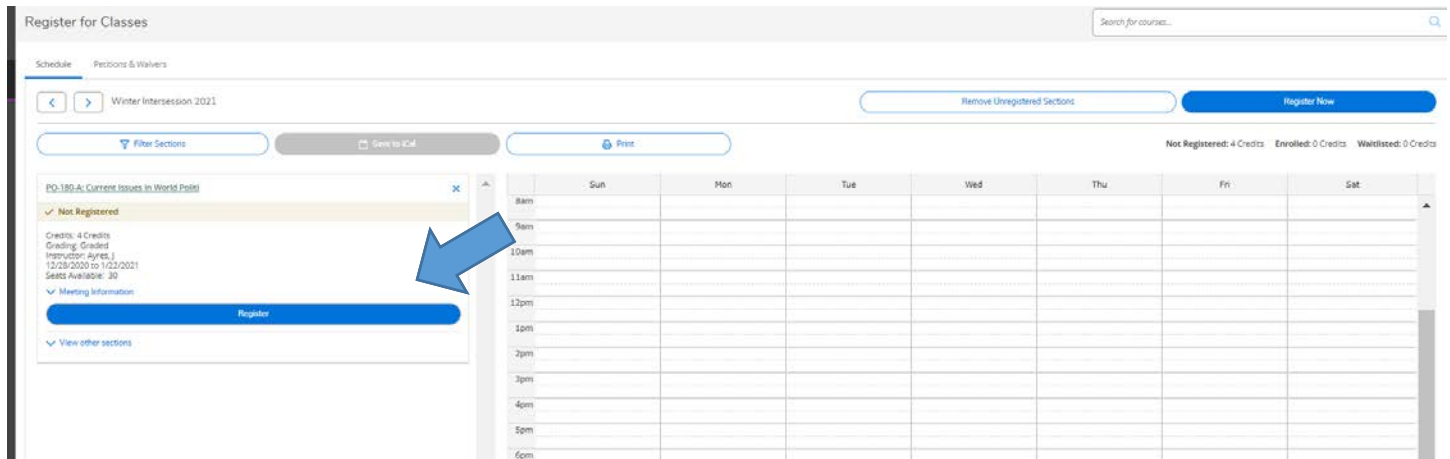

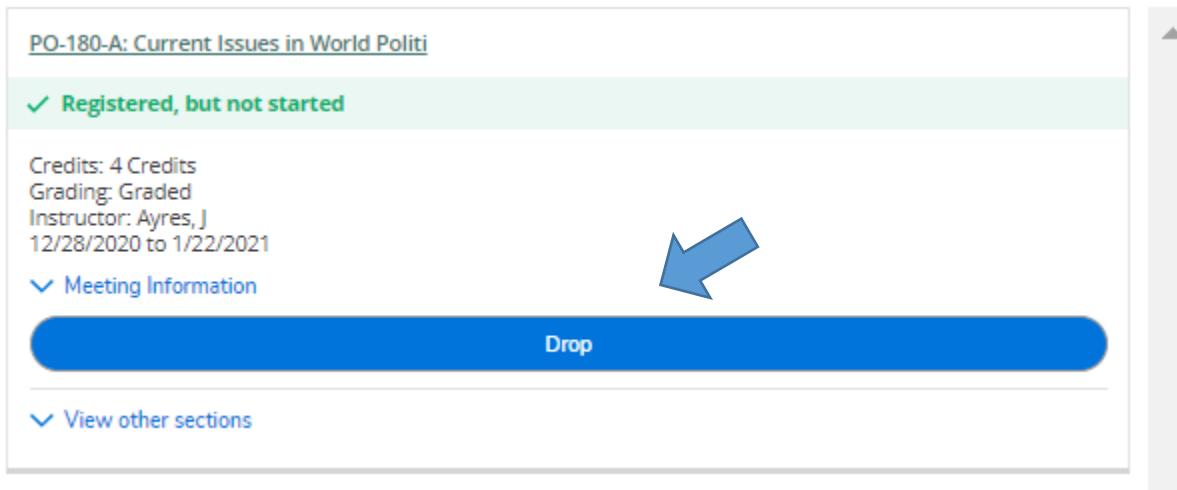
