Vermont's School Immunization Regulations apply to any student in attendance at any public or independent school. Before school entry, the student must have the required immunizations unless exempt for medical or religious reasons. Although the Sars Co-V 2 Vaccine is currently under an FDA Emergency Use Authorization, Saint Michael's College is requiring vaccination of its students due to the direct threat that Covid-19 has to individuals living and working on this campus.

You do have the right to waive this vaccine, citing a medical or religious reason. If you choose this exemption, you agree that you are well aware of your risk for Covid-19 and accept that.

You may also need to comply with various guidelines around quarantine, masking and limitations on gatherings/ visitors that others may no longer need to follow due to their vaccination status, depending on state and local levels of virus and subsequent guidance around that.
