### PROFESSOR ALLISON CLEARY

Professor Allison Cleary is a senior instructor in the Digital Media and Communications department at Saint Michael's College, where she focuses on journalism and writing, and often weaves community engaged learning into student projects. She is also Director of the Writing Center, and oversees the Peace Corps Prep program as a core member of the Institute for Global Engagement.



She is a former Peace Corps volunteer and has led international student service trips to Kolkata, India, the Dominican Republic, and Guatemala.

### PROFESSOR OMARA RIVERA-VÁZQUEZ

Professor Omara Rivera-Vazquez is the inaugural Director of the Center for Equity and Justice at Saint Michael's College, VT. She is a former Executive Director for The Community Restorative Justice Center, Inc. Dr. Rivera-Vázquez is also an Adjunct Professor of Criminal Justice at SUNY Oswego and the Vermont Law and Graduate School. She has published several peer-reviewed articles on social justice-related topics.



Dr. Rivera-Vázquez has been devoted to issues of diversity, equity, and inclusion throughout her career. At the national level, she serves as a Language Access consultant for the National Criminal Justice Association and the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Center. At the state level, she was awarded a grant from the VT Department of Health and additional support from Dartmouth-Hitchcock Clinic to conduct language access training and planning with all Community Justice Centers in Vermont.
