


Purple Knights Take the Field with the Lake Monsters

Edmundite Heritage Tour Explores the Legacy of Father Prevel and St. Edmund

In June, a group of Saint Michael's College alumni, trustees, faculty, staff, and friends traveled to England and France on the 2025 Edmundite Heritage Tour, following in the footsteps of Father Armand Prevel and St. Edmund. Led by the Edmundite Foundation and accompanied by



President Richard Plumb and his wife Mary, the group explored meaningful spiritual and historical sites in England, including Hitchin, Abingdon, Oxford, Salisbury, Stonehenge, and London. Those who joined the optional extension in France visited Pontigny in Burgundy and Mont Saint-Michel in Normandy, along with stops at the cathedrals of Rouen, Chartres, and Notre Dame in Paris. Other highlights included visits to Saint-Malo, Auxerre, and Château-Gontier, as well as a wine tasting hosted by Dr. Teryl Kinder, who teaches Fine Arts classes at Saint Michael's each Spring and resides near the Abbey of Pontigny. The tour concluded with a beautiful Seine River cruise in Paris, offering a memorable reflection on the Edmundite mission and community. Special thanks to Louis Giancola '68 and Fr. Marcel Rainville '67 for their leadership and dedication in bringing this meaningful journey to life.




