Summer Intern | US Fish and Wildlife Service, Essex Junction, Vermont (Summer 2024)

- Sea Lamprey Control team: monitored traps set up to capture invasive sea lamprey, clipped adults for tracking purposes, electrofished, and collected larval sea lamprey
- Trout Unlimited: created strategic wood additions, post-assisted log structures, and removed a dam, focused on decreasing erosion and improving river health
